# DESTRUCTION OF CULTURE BY ABUSE OF MEANING OF WORDS

## **SHABD-BRAHM:**

Under the Aryan culture, *Shabd* (the word) is described as 'Brahma'. This is so because words are medium of expression in any language and there is immense inherent strength in words. Words can make a culture, words can mar a culture.

## **A deep rooted conspiracy of the Western powers who are antagonist to the Hindu Religion:**

By introducing a very minor looking change in the words used in the 'mantras' in our religious scriptures, Max Muller and other persons sharing his antagonistic mentality, who are opposed to the vedic religion, succeeded in changing the entire meaning of the 'mantra'. By doing this, they have embarked on a propaganda implying that Vedas recommend meat-eating and that Vedas also contain certain rituals involving meat-eating for attaining certain goals. By this propaganda they have made herculean efforts to create a favourable mental inclination in Hindus towards meat eating.

There are millions of mantras in our religious scriptures. By slight changes in spelling, order/placement of word etc. somebody could tamper with the meaning of these mantras and attempt to project an absolutely distorted meaning. The contemporary scholars may not even be able to fully appreciate the impact of such minor looking change in the words or the meanings of words in the vedic mantras.

When such tampered texts of mantras are printed after a passage of years or even centuries and when they are approved by the State Authorities and also inserted in the educational curriculum of the country, the new generation may not even be aware that what is being taught to them is the tampered version of the mantras and not the original real version. Oblivious of this fact, the people who read such literature or mantras, tend to believe that what they are reading is the truth.

## **The unique gift of vedic religion to the world**

After reading the Gita and the Upanishads, the French Philosopher, Aquintele-the-Pere danced with joy and said that these were the greatest gifts to the world from the vedic religion. This reaction from Aquintele-the-Pere made Max Muller and other Christian priests jealous about the Hindu religion.

## **Jealousy of Maxmuller**

Maxmuller translated the vedas wrongly and then wrote a letter to his wife saying, "I have completed the task of translating vedas. This translation was necessary to destroy the 3000 years old culture which was emanating and

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prospering under the teachings of vedas. I may not remain alive to see destruction of this culture. However, I am confident that in the long run this translation will achieve the desired results. This will have a very grave impact on the Vedic religion”

### **The aims of Christian Missionaries**

Hindus believe that the Vedic religion is ‘Anadhi’ which means without having a definite point of time of its origin. In other words it means that they have always been there since time immemorial. To demolish this uniqueness of Vedas (of being in existence since time immemorial), the Christian Missionaries have undertaken a propaganda saying that vedas are not very old compared to Bible. They say that the Vedas are only about 1000 years older than Bible.

The text books on history and geography prepared by the British and which are still being taught in our schools, also contain a similar propaganda and it is thrust in the minds of children that Vedas are not ‘Anadhi’ but are of recent origin.

By imparting wrong meanings to the Vedas and by making changes in the Mantras contained in Vedas a very strong effort is being made to impress upon the minds of Hindus, that the Vedic Religion permits meat- eating and drinking of alcoholic liquor. They also make efforts to impress upon the Hindu minds that opposing meat eating or drinking of alcohol is a symbol of orthodoxy and backwardness.

The sole aim behind this great effort is to convert the entire Aryan population to Christianity by resorting to all possible ways such as persuasion, bribes, deceit or force; (i.e. ‘Sam’, ‘Dam’, ‘Bhed’ and ‘Dand’).

Some words borrowed from Vedas and subjected to a little change are used to project a totally different or distorted meaning and picture. For example, the Sanskrit word ‘mas’, which means a month. By small alteration of introducing a dot in the spelling, the word is written as ‘mans’ which means meat. By using this changed word out of context, the entire mantra is given a different meaning.

Another tactic is to quote only a part of the text of the mantra by omitting certain parts and retaining only that part or portion which is convenient to achieve the malicious object of the Christian Missionaries. By dissection of the text of mantras, the desired malicious meaning is sought to be given, instead of the original meaning flowing from the entire text of the mantras.

The Gita Press, Gorakhpur has published a Book in Hindi and English under the Title ‘Review of Belief - Ancient India’. This book gives the original text of many mantras as well as the amended text. It also gives the original meaning of the mantras as well as the distorted meanings given to mantras after changing them.

Somebody may raise a doubt as to why is it necessary to make the Indians eat meat and drink alcohol to convert them to Christianity. The answer to this doubt is contained in the letters of Mr. Sydney H. Brown.

## **Confession of Mr. Brown**

Mr. Brown writes, "The meat - eating and drinking habits of the Christian missionaries are the biggest obstacles in spreading the Christian religion in a country like India. Thousands of years before Jesus Christ, the Vedic religion has forbidden meat eating'. (Here the Author of this letter, Mr. Brown himself confesses that Vedic religion forbids meat eating and consumption of Alcohol).

The Western Scholars started a mischievous propaganda saying that the Vedic religion permits meat eating and drinking of alcohol. This propaganda is for achieving certain definite goals. It is a pity for our nation that the person who started this propaganda and who almost established that Vedas permit meat eating, is considered as the father of Vedas by the Indians.

Mr. Brown writes further in his letter that "Gautam Buddha and Jarthostra (the Religious head of Parsis) have also forbidden meat-eating. The Islam religion strictly forbids drinking of alcohol. Then how can we expect that the Hindus, the Buddhas, the Parsis and the Muslims will consider Christianity as a better religion and accept it.

Their religious feelings and hereditary beliefs of several generations will naturally consider the Christian religion as much inferior, as it permits meat eating and drinking of alcohol.

When our Priests will present themselves before the Indian population as persons indulging in meat-eating and alcohol, will they not be considered as very much inferior persons in the eyes of Indians?

When people consider our Christian missionaries as much inferior to them, how can they accept the religion and culture propagated by such missionaries?"

### **Lessons learnt by the British :**

It would be appreciated from the above that it was not easy to convert the Indian population towards Christianity unless they were diverted towards meat eating and consumption of intoxicants.

The Muslim had succeeded in propagating Islam by use of their sword in other countries, but they had miserably failed in India.

Even the Portuguese did not spare any efforts and inflicted horrible tyranny on Hindus on the Western coast of India to convert them to Christianity. The tales of their deeds are too horrible. However, even they could not succeed in converting the Hindus and even the Muslims to Christianity.

The British learnt lessons from the above and instead of attaining conversion by inflicting terror, they adopted an altogether different strategy. They started a long term scheme and that scheme is being implemented in stages even today.

## **Hindu Culture - A culture totally different from other Cultures of the world**

The Christian or Islam religion could be spread in other countries of the world except India, with great speed and fervour mainly for the reason that the population of such countries was a meat eating population.

India had the rich treasure of the knowledge of Vedic religion, which is crores of years old. It had noble ideals and it also had a very well organised social structure based on four pillars of preservation and protection of animals, forests, soil and water resources. Its social structure was time-tested and it worked without any hitch or obstacle. All the aspects of its social existence, i.e. religion, culture, economy etc. were very well defined and well conducted. Such a social organisation and structure was not available with the other populations of the world.

In view of this situation, the other populations of the world had nothing at stake and they had hardly anything to lose in accepting Islamic or Christian religion. Hence they surrendered to the sword of Islam or Christianity.

### **Roots of the undithering Indian Population embedded in its culture:**

Any population would fiercely oppose any onslaught which is likely to destroy its pious religious principles or very noble moral values. Such fierce opposition was not possible in any other country.

Countries after country started crumbling down before the might of the armies of Alexander and other Islamic invaders in the absence of a very strong internal social organisation based on strong economy, and pious religious as well as moral values; and these countries had no option but to embrace the Islamic or Christian religion.

However, this did not happen in India. Alexander had to return from the boundaries of India with a heart broken by a sense of defeat.

For more than two centuries, the Islamic armies coming to sweep India like a hurricane were also held back on the border post of this nation, at a place called Gijni.

On each step of their march beyond the boundaries of India, these armies had to face self-immolations and sacrifice by brave Indians and fierce opposition from Indian people. Despite their efforts spreading over 700 years, the Muslim invaders failed to convert India into a Muslim country.

The hatred and despise of Hindus towards meat eating and consumption of intoxicants and their religious teachings which made them consider the meat eaters and alcohol consumers as persons of a very low category as also their knowledge about Vedic religion provided them enough courage and strength to sacrifice their life for saving their religion.

And hence, like crores of people in other countries of the world, who bowed to Christianity and Islam at one stroke, India did not bow to the wishes of the perpetrators of these two religions.

## **Tyrant oppression and offer of monetary temptations to break the noble ideals of religion:**

Despite fierce attempts by the Muslims, spanning over several centuries, India did not become a Muslim country.

Despite various plans spanning over last two centuries; despite various frauds, conspiracies, pressures and active efforts for conversion, and despite spending crores of rupees towards this end, the population of Christians in India is hardly 150 lakhs.

Even those who have converted themselves to Christianity have not done so after being impressed by the noble ideals of the Christian religion.

There is a long history of various frauds and conspiracies in which the British indulged during their rule in India. They indulged in cruel steps like cow slaughter on large scale and rendered millions of families unemployed and poor, and by creating conditions of acute poverty these families were compelled to embrace Christianity. The history of such misdeeds is deliberately erased now. The British inflicted untold miseries on millions of Hindu families using their authority as rulers and by indulging in various anti-Indian policies. They could convert some of these families to Christianity by throwing bait of some monetary and social benefits to them. To prevent them from abandoning the Christian religion, they are being given economic bait on continuous basis.

The people who embraced the Christian religion were not the people who had a good knowledge about Hindu religion. They were people from the lowest economic rungs of the Indian society, where they were thrown due the anti-Indian policies of the British.

However, such Christian religion which owes its spread to fraud and conspiracy could get blown and lost like a straw in a hurricane.

The British were not unaware that unless the affluent and higher rung of the society accepted Christian religion, the roots of that religion in India were not safe.

And therefore to bring the higher rung of the Society in the fold of Christian religion, it was necessary to create doubts in their minds about the Vedic religion (so that their faith in the Vedic religion gets destroyed and with destruction of this faith their strong spirit to lay down their life for protecting the religion also gets destroyed) and towards this end they started an aggressive campaign and propaganda stating that the Vedic religion permits meat eating, drinking of intoxicants etc.

## **Utter failure of the propaganda for promoting meat eating:**

The British got the literature prepared for propagating meat eating and drinking of liquor by the contemporary well known people like Raja Rajendralal Mitra, Swami Bhumanand, Kane etc. They played mischief with the religious scriptures and epics and even 'beef eating clubs' were established.

Despite these efforts, the British could not succeed in converting the higher echelons of the Society towards meat eating and the great scholars of vedic religion could also not be impressed by the propaganda of the Christian religion.

The British therefore withdrew the propaganda campaign and started another strategy of playing with the meanings of words.

### **Use of mesmerizing wordy missiles:**

If a particular word is coined and tossed around ceaselessly in the society every day with its distorted meaning, the opposition to such distorted meaning gets blunted with passage of time.

One such word is '**FAT**'. The phrase 'fat percent' in the context of milk means percentage content of fat in milk.

However, milk does not contain fat, it contains '*ghee*'.

Fat and '*ghee*' are totally different substances. Their characteristics are totally different.

Ever since cow, milk and ghee have been parts of the Indian Society, fat and '*ghee*' were used as two different words in the Sanskrit language and both had different meanings.

For fat, the Sanskrit word was '*med*' and for '*ghee*' the Sanskrit word was '*Ghrit*'. What is the content of ghee in milk - this was the proper way of expressing the '*ghee*' content in milk. It was never expressed as the content of '*med*' (fat) in milk. During performance of a '*yagna*' what was offered to fire was '*ghee*' and not fat or '*med*'. '*Med*' was never used in place of ghee.

The British coined the phrase 'fat percentage' in milk instead of '*ghee*' content or the '*ghee*' percent. As part of a long term strategy they placed before us three substances i.e. *Ghee*, edible oil and fat. Edible oil is described as vegetable based fat, while *ghee* and fat are described as animal based fats. The Hindu scriptures have described all the three as different substances.

### ***Ghee*, vegetable oil and fat, 3 different substances**

In Sanskrit language the words for *ghee*, vegetable oil and fat are '*Ghritam*', '*Tailyam*', and '*Med*' respectively.

In Gujarati as well as other Indian languages, the usual expressions are: 'This is oil of til', or 'this is oil of mustard', or 'this is the ***ghee*** of cow', or this is the ***ghee*** of a buffalo'. Instead it is not said, 'this is fat of til or mustard'. Similarly it is not said that 'this is **fat** of a cow or a buffalo'. Such expressions are not used because *ghee*, edible oil and **fat** are altogether three different substances and Hindus abhor words like fat, meat etc.

By the British system of education, all three substances i.e. edible oil, *ghee* and fat were described as three different kind of fat only and this idea was planted in the minds of the younger generation of Hindus.

Everyday, day after day, the phrase 'fat percent', meaning the percentage of fat in milk started pounding our ears and over a period of time we accepted this expression and the meaning of *ghee* got converted as **fat**. And nobody realised the malicious intentions behind this conspiracy of playing with the meaning of words.

The new generation was obsessed with use of English words in its routine conversation and thereby project itself as scholar and reformer.

Thus the expression 'fat percent' was often used and with its consistent use over decades, even the higher rung of the society started believing that '*ghee*' and fat are one and the same thing.

This expression became so popular with repeated use that many upper castes Hindus, who graduated in the veterinary science, and others also started using the expression 'fat percent' in place of *ghee*.

Following the footsteps of such veterinary experts, the columnists in newspapers, who hardly had any knowledge of the subject, also started writing on the contents and qualities of milk based on the tables prepared by the foreigners to exhibit their own expertise and dished out statistics about the percentage of water, the percentage of minerals, the percentage of calcium and the percentage of fat in milk. Such articles in newspaper columns also served the desired purpose of planting a notion in the minds of readers that *ghee* means fat only.

People who are involved in the day to day life with cattle, with milk and with *ghee*; people involved in production and sale of milk and *ghee*, as also the herdsmen who rear cattle may not be even aware that the holy substance of *ghee* is now recognised as fat in the society. They may not accept this equation of *ghee* with fat, however, the columnists of newspapers have coined this expression so effectively that the educated higher rung of the society has accepted fat as synonym of *ghee*.

It will be appropriate at this place to inform the readers about the characteristics of *ghee* and fat.

### **Supreme Qualities of *Ghee*:**

*Ghee* is a source for increasing strength, it increases '*virya*', it increases the longevity of human beings, and postpones setting in of old age, it strengthens the heart, it destroys the root causes of various illnesses such as '*vat*', '*pitt*', and '*cough*' (which are the root causes of all diseases as per Ayurved). *Ghee* is tasty, it has a very pleasant flavour and it helps retain youthfulness. If the *ghee* is of a cow, the digestive system will be so effective that all the poisonous substances are thrown out of the body. It also increases the quality of vision.

### **Fat - a Source of disease and a damaging substance**

Fat has none of the qualities that *ghee* has. It has no taste. If it is taken with food, it is indigestible and it gets thrown out of the body with stool. However, before leaving the body, it gives rise to many diseases in the body.

The body does not get any nutrition from fat. On the contrary, it may induce dysentery, gas and constipation. It kills appetite. It creates ulcers in intestines or blood vessels and if various minerals and calcium which enter a human's body through modern medicine, get deposited in such ulcers, such situation can give rise to Angina (a type of heart disease) which may eventually lead to death.

Growing incidence of heart diseases in persons of all age group can be attributed to the consumption of this fat which knowingly or unknowingly enters the bodies of human beings through various food substances which create these diseases. The presence of fat in the body creates many poisonous substances and even damages kidney and causes ulcers, cancer etc.

### **Meat eating and fat consumption - The root causes of serious diseases**

Cancer, ulcer, arthritis, kidney and heart diseases have mushroomed in Europe and America like the growth of earth worms during monsoon. Out of several reasons or causes of these diseases, one of the main reason or cause is that the Europeans and the Americans eat meat like gluttons. Their per capita consumption of animal fat either from cow or from pig is 15 to 20 gm.

Eggs, meat, fats and fish create various types of poisons in the body and these poisons manifest themselves in the form of above described diseases.

Even after presenting ghee as fat, the Indian population did not accept fat in its food. Then by various administrative steps and using their position as rulers, the British created shortage of *ghee* and encouraged mixing of fat in pure *ghee*. People who used to trade dealing in non-vegetarian food stuffs, started using fat liberally in their products.

### **The foresight and precaution of the great sage Manu**

In his book Manusmriti, the great Indian sage Manu had forbidden the trade of cooked food for Hindus. The apparent reason behind such a dictum was that if somebody sold cooked food, there was scope for adulterating the same with all sorts of eatable and non-eatable substances. The greed for money can lead a person to do all sorts of bad deeds.

It is not that the non-eatable substances adversely affect only the body after entering it as food. The greater damage is to the mind of a person. The mind becomes wicked and it keeps the human beings away from deeds which ought to be performed and leads to the deeds which ought to be avoided. The human mind feels proud to do things which ought not be done. Thus such non-eatable things are a source of grave danger for Hindu culture.

### **Care exercised by our forefathers against the wicked designs of the British**

The Europeans promoted the use of ready biscuits in India. In the beginning Hindus did not even touch bread and biscuits.

There was a widespread belief amongst Hindus, when the Europeans first started propagating use of breads and biscuits in India, that bread contains the blood or meat of a cow. Hence the Hindus considered bread and biscuits as untouchable.

People in those times were always conscious as to which food was eatable and which was not. They were apprehensive and conscious that the British were hatching conspiracies to convert them to Christianity by propagating meat eating and drinking of intoxicants.

### **Poor villagers trapped in the web of bread**

The Europeans took advantage of the above stated doubts of Hindus, and made a smart move.

There was an old custom in Indian villages that people used to go for taking bath in the early morning at wells outside the village. On their return they would fetch water for their household needs.

There used to be several wells in the same village. However, the characteristics of water even from neighbouring wells used to differ. Hence the well which had soft water, used to be patronised by the entire village for their drinking water needs.

The Europeans would throw crumbs of bread in such wells during night or during early morning. The villagers would go to the wells much before the dawn for taking bath and for fetching drinking water. In the dim light of dawn they would not notice the crumbs of bread in the well water. At the day break, when the crumbs of bread will be visible in the water of wells, the Christians would instigate the villagers saying that they (villagers) had now consumed water which contained crumbs of breads prepared with the help of cow's beef and hence they were converted to Christianity.

### **Conversion with the help of bread and money**

As per predetermined arrangements, the news would be spread in neighbouring villages that the people in so and so village had consumed water which contained bread made of cow beef and that they had become Christians. As soon as this news would spread, the people of neighbouring villages would socially boycott the so-called converts of this village and thus the residents of this village would have no other option but to embrace Christian religion.

Around the same period, the Indian villages were suffering from acute poverty as a result of tyrant actions of the British. Such converted poor villagers were then offered financial aid by the priests and missionaries. As a result of this financial aid, when a similar fraud was repeated in some other village and that village also became socially boycotted, then the people in such village would easily convert themselves to Christianity, tempted by the economic aid given by priests and missionaries.

Thus fraud and economic aid became their sure weapons and these weapons are being used against us even now. In the name of aid, the noose of dependence and slavery is slowly tightening around the nation's neck.

I have met several such Christians who informed me that earlier they were **Samvedi Brahmins**. Their forefathers were converted to Christianity as a result of the above stated mode of fraud involving bread crumbs and water.

I asked them, "if your forefathers were converted to Christianity by fraud why don't you once again convert yourself to Hinduism? Come, this very moment I will initiate you back into Hinduism". They replied, "How does it benefit us? Even today we get from the Church aid by way of free education, free medical aid, free treatment even where operations are involved in hospitals. We are given free assistance for getting loans for fertilizer and seeds for our farms, for wells, for irrigation etc."

Then they added, "You Hindus do not extend any such help and assistance to us. Whereas these Christian priests offer loans even to non-Christians. If such non-Christian borrowers are unable to repay their loan, then the loans are written off on the condition that the loanees should convert themselves to Christianity".

Thus the game of conversion in the name of aid is continuing even today. What a colossal fraud must be lurking behind the aid of billions of dollars which is being extended to our country; God alone knows! However, if the people do not remain alert and give a free hand to the govt. for obtaining the so-called aids and allowing the nation to be trapped in the conspiracies of the Western countries and if the people and politicians of this nation continue to bother only about their own selfish interest, the responsibility of the coming doom will lie with the people only, because, the criminal negligence of enforcing their rights under the democratic set up would be the reason for inviting the most severe form of disaster.

Bread became a successful weapon to convert the illiterate rural masses to Christianity. Thereafter the British started spreading of the biscuit culture amongst the literate masses.

They would serve their invited Hindu guests with tea and biscuits, saying that the biscuits were perfectly vegetarian, nutritious and were easy to digest. The Hindu guests would be told that the 'purees' they (Hindus) consumed were hard to digest, because they were deep fried.

It is unfortunate that no Vaidya challenged this claim. Biscuits made from 'maida' (i.e. the super fine flour of wheat) can never be easier to digest compared to purees.

In the Western countries the deep fried varieties of food are fried in the animal fats obtained from pigs or cows, because they are not aware what 'ghee' is! The vegetable oil is costlier than fats. The adverse effects of fats have been described above and because of these adverse features, doctors in Western countries forbid eating of fried substances.

Allopathy has come to India from Britain. And hence, without knowing as to why the deep fried things are not eaten by people in Western countries, the doctors in India also prescribed that the patients should not eat deep fried

things. This advice of not eating fried things has become so strong by its daily excessive use that people are now afraid to eat deep fried things, as they would be afraid of cancer or such other fatal diseases. They consider it a matter of pride not to eat deep fried food.

### **Hindus became physically weak after falling prey to this propaganda of not eating deep fried things**

The propaganda of not eating deep fried things demolished the very basis of our nutrition. Not only this, this propaganda made us suspicious against various sweetmeats cooked in pure ghee. These sweets were not only very tasty but also nutritious. The Hindus have now almost abandoned these sweets.

On the other hand there was aggressive propaganda in newspapers and other mediums emphasizing the need of 'protein for nutrition'. This aggressive propaganda reduced the abhorrence of people towards eggs, meat and fish and the magic of the word 'protein' lured people towards eating things which were not eatable. People who longed to project themselves as reformists, started taking pride in eating these things.

### **Damage to the Indian culture and prosperity with the help of biscuits**

Propaganda for biscuits inflicted serious blows to the fortress like religious feelings of the Indians.

This propaganda was coupled with very severe exploitation of the people. Wheat used to be very cheap in those years. The present generation will not believe that wheat was available at the rate of 20 kg. (a mond) for Rs. 1.50 only. However, the European merchants would make advance payment to the farmers in Punjab and would buy their entire crop of wheat offering a price of only 75 paise for 20 kg. This wheat was sent to England and was used for making biscuits. These biscuits were sold in India at the rate of Rs. 2.00 per kg. Thus the Indians would pay Rs. 2 for a kilo of wheat which was sold by their farmers at 75 paise for 20 kgs. In the quest of being called reformists, the so-called modern Indians were made to pay Rs. 40/- for 20 kg. of wheat (in the form of biscuits) which was sold for just 75 paise by the farmers!

### **The association of the phrase 'fat percent' with milk destroyed the hatred of people towards fat and meat**

The Allopathic doctors, as though they were selling agents of the British biscuits, would recommend to their patients consumption of biscuits as a light diet. Later on biscuits manufacturing factories were set up in India also. However, in the absence of butter for making biscuits these factories had to use vegetable ghee. And if fat is cheaper than vegetable ghee, why not use fat? How would people know? and even if they come to know later on, their condition would be the same as the condition of those who consumed water in village wells wherein crumbs of bread were thrown. This is so because now when everybody consumes biscuits how can one be blamed? If at all anybody was to be blamed it was the manufacturers of biscuits! If there is any sin in

this, the blame lies with the biscuit manufacturers! And don't we consume 'fat percent' in the milk? Thus people would reconcile themselves with such arguments. If everybody consumes a non-eatable, naturally it becomes an eatable and such a thing becomes even as holy as the water of river Ganges! Now the native or the Indian British are more enthusiastic than the real British to make people eat the things which are non-eatable, by perpetrating frauds. The following instance is worth noting.

In the year 1967, the Govt. refused to impose a total ban on slaughter of cow and cow family. The Jagadguru Shri Shankaracharya of Puri started fast unto death to protest against this decision of the Govt.

The Govt. then declared, "we are not against banning cow slaughter. We have introduced Article 48 in the Constitution for protection of cow only. (yet it is another sad story that for the past 45 years the country is ignoring the command of the Constitution and the slaughter of cows and cow family not only continues, but it has increased with each passing year). However, we are appointing a committee to study the economic repercussion on the nation if we impose a total ban on cow slaughter." (in fact the need was to appoint a committee to study the adverse effects of continuing cow slaughter for the past 135 years, on the nation's economy, the nation's glory and its culture).

The Committee was appointed with 16 members. 3 of the members were against the slaughter of cow, one of them being the Shankaracharya himself and two members from The All India Maha Abhiyan Goraksha Samiti.

This Goraksha Committee invited the views in writing as well as recorded oral interviews of the concerned institutions, govt. and some govt. officers and others who were either in favour or against the cow slaughter.

One of the members of the Maha Adbhiyan Samiti stated, 'If the feed for poultry birds is made with the help of cow's beef, the weight of the egg of the bird increases by 50% The cow beef contains 84% protein!' (In fact protein percentage in cows' beef is only 22%).

### **Educated Hindus only in the forefront in adulterating food-stuffs with animal fat & meat**

One of the members of the Committee asked, 'but then people do not eat meat and eggs, so what about it'?

The person from Maha Abhiyan Samiti replied, "we should feed the people with eggs and meat by mixing them in other food articles in a way that people do not come to know about such adulteration. Once people eat these things unknowingly, they would shed their hatred for these things and then they would themselves demand these things for eating."

This gentleman had come from the camp opposed to the slaughter of cow. However, in his statement, he only narrated the benefits from slaughter of a cow!. His comment about the living cows was this "the population of cows in our country is 31 crores. (as per Govt. figures the population is only 5 crores). There is no fodder for all these cows and hence their population must be reduced."

## **Co-operative slaughter houses under the garb of co-operative farming**

Thus after misleading and confusing the people with expressions like fat percent, protein, malnutrition, secularism etc., the black native British have been dragging the Indian people towards meat eating and intoxicants with much more courage, much more speed and much more zeal than the White British.

Under the garb of providing supplementary income to the villagers, they have initiated pig rearing in place of rearing of cows (and have also destroyed cows). They have initiated the activity of poultry in each household in rural area, instead of spreading the message of the spinning wheel. They have propagated eggs in a big way and have destroyed the grazing lands in villages. Now under the garb of co-operative farming they have formulated and started implementing schemes of co-operative slaughter houses for slaughtering pigs.

## **A very dreadful and destructive conspiracy to convert the entire Hindu population to meat eating**

The real means of creating supplementary income for the farmers in villages should be the spinning wheel, the bullock cart and the production of pure ghee. All these three means of supplementary income must exist in each household. However, insurmountable obstructions have been created against the three things and the farmers have been compelled to abandon all these three. In their place, rearing of pigs and sheep is promoted and slaughter houses are set up for slaughtering them. To promote the use of eggs and poultry activity, free eggs are distributed to school children in the name of providing nutrition. Large advertisements are carried in the media depicting 'protein-rich- food', which are adulterated with contents of eggs and the flour of dry fish. All these devilish activities are indulged in by the ruling class and if the people at large nurture a fear that there is a grand conspiracy of the Western countries behind all these anti-religion, anti-nation, anti-culture and anti-nature steps, their fears are not misplaced.

There is a rumour that as per the directions of 'Applied Nutrition For Food' Institution of the United Nations, fish are dried near Dwarka, de-odourised and their flour is mixed in the flour of gram and wheat.

There is news that a Rs.12 crore plant is being set up for fish processing at Porbandar, the birth place of Mahatma Gandhi. When a decision was taken to set up this plant, a doctor from Rajkot had requested the then Prime Minister Shri Morarji Desai not to take such a step. Morarji Desai had shot back, "the plant will definitely be set up, can I let people die of starvation?"

## **Do people die of starvation? If so, what happened to the foodgrains production of 12.1/2 crore tons?**

The pertinent question is, do people die of starvation despite the record foodgrain production of 12.1/2 crores tons and hence whether it is necessary to feed them with the dried fish flour on the sly? Our diesel import bill is Rs.4000 crore p.a. Is it that we have to export meat worth Rs. 4000 crore to the Arab nations in return for the diesel which we import?

For the last 4 years our country has increased tremendously the slaughter of animals and now there is shortage of animals for slaughtering also. And hence in place of meat and beef, whether we are compelled to give away our foodgrains to the Arab Nations, and by luring people in our country in the name of protein the govt. has to feed them with the fish flour?

O' the leaders of our nation! ( who describe themselves as the followers of Gandhiji) Don't you feel any compunction in playing with the religious feelings of the people and leading them to meat-eating by playing frauds on them? There are apprehensions that there might be unwritten conditions of converting the entire population towards meat eating behind various international aids and loans for the schemes like the Narmada Scheme etc. One should not feel astonished if such doubts are nurtured by the people.

A rumour has been gaining ground that with the consent of the Cabinet of Ministers at the Central and State level, various food stuffs are adulterated with eggs, meat, fat, fish flour etc. and such food stuffs are fed to people by fraud. It is possible that these may not be just rumours, this might be the truth also. However, these ministers should not forget that a great mutiny had erupted in 1857 due to application of cow and pig fat on the cartridges of the guns of Indian soldiers in the British army.

### **The population is bound to awake**

If this government wants its people to abandon its culture, its Indianness and get converted to Christianity, then it will have to face the kind of agitation and protest which the world has never witnessed in its history. When the masses will awake, they will crush the mightiest of the rulers. The day of reckoning for the Indians is not far, when either they will have to restore Indianness to Indians and throw out the puppet like govt. of the country dancing to the tune of the Westerners or to face total extinction of the Indian masses.

If India is to be Indianised and if the Hindu culture, Hindu religion and the Hindu social order is to be saved, the Indians will have to become careful against words like marine products, socialism, democracy, nutrition, fat percentage, protein, secularism etc.

The magical effect of some of the above words on the Indian population, their lives and their culture are described in the following paragraphs.

Given below are some such illusory words which have become common place by their continuous use. Without realising their real meaning, by their continuous use we have lost our sense and wisdom to realise their ill-effect and we are rushing towards our doom like the insects rushing towards a burning flame, falling prey to the web of these words.

### **Vitamin**

By daily hammering of the word 'Vitamin' we forgot milk and pure ghee and thus the instances of diseases increased. With growing diseases, vitamin injections were invented to combat weakness and it became a sort of status symbol to take vitamin injections!

## **Protein**

We accepted the need for protein and the magic of this word drew people towards eggs. Foodgrains also contain proteins, but the word 'protein' was predominantly and exclusively associated with eggs and thus under the magical influence of the word protein, consumption of eggs became a necessity.

## **Farm products**

People by and large believe that farm products mean foodgrains, but no, now it is not so. The farmers are induced to rear pigs, sheep and poultry birds on their farms. Because these animals and birds are reared on the agricultural farms, their eggs and meat after slaughter are described as 'farm products'. Various food products are manufactured from eggs and meat by using 'food-technology' and like popularising bread and biscuits in each households, it is not surprising that these 'food products' are being popularised as 'protein-rich-food' from farm products. Now even the doctors advise their patients under the direction of the Govt. that the patients should avoid cereals and fried things and instead consume 'farm products'.

## **Marine products**

Marine products means fish. If people are advised to eat fish flour they may agitate. In view of this, an air was created some years ago that there are various types of vegetations in the sea which can be used as nutritious food by the people. The availability of these vegetations is in large quantum and it grows every day. Now there will not be any problem of shortage of foodgrains. Such propaganda news were highlighted in newspapers and periodicals at regular intervals and then fish was placed before the people as marine product!

Under the magical influence of the word 'protein' fish would become slowly acceptable to the higher rungs of the Society as a source of protein. Fish are dried, de-odourised and ground to make flour and this flour is filled in capsule which are sold as protein medicine.

If the magical effect of word 'protein' could succeed in removing the hatred of the people and their religious protest against meat; in days to come it is possible that dry fish flour may be mixed with liquor and such liquor may be branded and sold as 'protein rich liquor'!

It is also possible that food stuffs may be prepared using the flour of dried fish and sold as protein rich food for good health. An army of more than one lakh doctors is ready to propagate such food as tonic.

## **Nutrition**

Nutrition is an orthodox word. It reminds one of pure ghee and fresh milk. Hence not a single opportunity is lost to associate the necessity of eggs chicken etc. with the word 'nutrition' and such associating of nutrition with eggs, chicken etc. is planted in the minds of people. Now-a-days young people from affluent families on their own ask the doctors whether they should take eggs for nutrition. If the doctor is wise and says no, he is immediately asked, 'but doctor something has to be taken from protein, isn't it? The devil of protein has now affected everyone.

## **Fat percent**

Milk contains ghee, not fat. Ghee is converted during digestion process into 'virya'. Fat does not get converted into any other thing and gets thrown out of the body with stool. However, by daily hammering of the word 'fat percent' people have started considering ghee only as fat. Their opposition to fat has subsided. And now the conspiracy is being implemented to introduce the fat of cows and pigs in the daily diet of the people in place of pure ghee. People may not be aware of this in the beginning stages. Later on when they learn about this, they will not have the required physical energy and moral courage to resist this conspiracy.

## **Secularism**

The old English dictionaries gave the meaning of secularism as 'anti-God' and 'anti-religion'. Nehru had a dislike towards the concept of God and religion. He was in love with science. Therefore, to achieve total destruction of religion in the country, he declared our country as a secular State. In order to overcome the likely protest from people, the meaning of 'secularism' in the edition of English dictionaries coming to India was changed and instead of the correct meaning i.e. 'anti-God' and 'anti-religion' the word 'secularism' was defined as 'not concerned with religion and God'. Secularism was given the meaning in our country as 'Dharma Nirapeksh' i.e. not concerned with Dharma. By this changed meaning of secularism, the people were led to behave in a fashion which was against religion. An atmosphere was created in the entire country to despise people who believed in and practiced religion, by branding them as people indulging in something which is not permitted in a secular state. A class of people who despised religion was created in the country. For example when it was proposed that the then President Shri Rajendra Prasad, should inaugurate the temple of Somnath, Nehru had tried his best to prevent Rajendra Prasad from performing this inauguration. When President Shri Radhakrishnan, Shri V.V. Giri and persons like them holding high offices in the State used to go on pilgrimage or visited temples, some columnists in newspapers used to criticize them saying that it is unbecoming of a Head of a Secular State to go for pilgrimage or Darshan in temples.

Possibly India is the only country in the whole world which brands itself as a secular State and which on one hand creates all sorts of obstruction and obstacles against the Hindu religion in the name of secularism, and on the other hand it dare not touch other religions existing and practised in India. Both these contradictory positions are sustained by the same magic of secularism.

## **Democracy**

The magical umbrella of 'democracy' can be used to provide protection to any evil or wicked design which damages the nation, its culture and the religion.

Any demand of people which might be in the national interest can be refused in the name of democracy! On top of it, it can be said, "yes you have a point, your demand is good, but what can be done? Ours is a democracy, this is a secular State!"

## **Tube well**

A missile in the form of the word 'tube well' has been fired from America with such accuracy that it has succeeded in pushing the sub-soil water level upto a thousand feet deep below the soil in Saurashtra. The vacuum so created below the soil level is occupied by the salted sea water and this has made the entire stretch of most fertile soil saline. However, despite this disaster, we still are unable to give up the idea of tube well. Tube wells may increase the foreign debt burden on our head, however, this is no cause for concern! It cannot wean us away from the magic of tube well. Initially the cost of digging a tube well was only Rs. 10000/- . Today the situation is such that a tube well cannot be dug even after spending Rs. 70000/-. Despite this phenomenal increase in cost and disastrous effect on soil, we are unable to come out of the magical clutch of tube well and a survey is going on at the cost of lakhs of rupees to find out as to where the tube wells will succeed in the Kutch region. May be with passage of time, digging a tube well may cost Rs. 10 lakhs. However, the tube well has dug itself so firmly in the hearts of people that it cannot be driven out!

## **Protein rich**

This phrase has the magical powers to convert any non-eatable substance into an eatable, any unholy thing into a holy thing and to convert any nutritionless and damaging substance into a very high quality eatable!

## **Increased production**

Every Minister of the country, every political leader, every industrialist, trader, middle man or student, each one says in a single voice "the country can be saved only by increased production. Increased production is the question of life and death for us". Seminars are arranged on the subject or theme of increase in production. Editorials are written in leading newspapers and columnists propagate these words filling columns after columns in newspapers.

"Increase production" This phrase is so magical that despite increase of only 63% in population, as against increase of 100% to 4000% in production of foodgrains and other items of necessity (India 1974, Page 175, 235 and 236), all sections of the Society say only one thing - increase the production, increase the production. These words have acted as a curtain concealing the evils of hoarding, the exploitation generated by hoarding and the economic disparities amongst various sections of society.

## **Improved seeds and chemical fertilisers**

The illusory web created by these words is such that in the flood light of their glamour, people are unable to realise the adverse effects of their use, the exploitation of people by the vested interest involved in these areas and the diseases which are spread amongst the people by consumption of foodgrains grown by using them. There is constant propaganda in newspapers, by lectures, by radio programmes etc. and the people have been so much brainwashed with constant use of these words that they feel that there is no alternate to these so-called improved seeds and chemical fertiliser.

## **Foreign exchange**

Foreign exchange has made the people so much hypnotised that the worst of the deeds and even traitor like activities are also justified if they result in generation of foreign exchange. Possibly in the quest of foreign exchange, the country may export even children and women in future. The most productive or qualitative manpower as also brain-power is permitted to be exported as it brings in foreign exchange!

## **Destroy casteism**

The propaganda for destruction of casteism has confused people so much, that in the name of destroying casteism they have destroyed character and culture. Castes have been converted into a pawn in the hands of political players for promoting their own selfish ends. Despite this, people say with one voice that casteism is the root cause for the backwardness of our country! These people have created new castes such as the Lions, the Rotarians, parties like Congress etc. which are much greater castes than the castes existent in India. All these castes have their roots in the Western countries.

## **Education**

One of the most dangerous but hypnotic missile is the word 'education'. The real purpose and aim of education is to build good character and moral. However, the British thrust upon us, in the name of education, the Western culture, the Western way of thinking and the Western economy . They have limited the meaning of the word 'education' only to the knowledge of English language and now the purpose of education is only to obtain jobs.

The present system of education has taught the younger generation to show disrespect to the elders, to the sages and saints, to the Hindu culture and religion. Selfish interests have gained precedence over the interest of the society and the nation. In the name of individual independence, people have been thrown towards abuse of this independence and led into activities which tear apart the society in shreds. People have started believing that the pride of one's life lie in consuming liquor, meat eating and visiting night clubs. The wise sayings of our religious scriptures are forgotten and now we memorize the Western sayings. Despite this, the sages and saints of our society, the religious heads, the preachers, the social leaders and the business community keep encouraging our youth to learn English language and English way of thinking in the name of education. Not only this, they render all assistance and help to raise funds of crores of rupees to help the spread of this education.

Instead of training the guns of education towards the onslaught of Western culture, Western way of thinking and Western economy, our saints and sages, preachers and social leaders have trained this gun against our own religion, culture and social order; and to keep the attack mounted they spend billions of rupees to achieve this end.

This is a very vivid example of intellectual blindness which has pervaded the entire country, in the name of education.

## **Farm product**

The real meaning of the word 'farm product' is the agricultural products which grow in a farm, such as all types of cereals and foodgrains, cotton, sugarcane, oil seeds, tea, coffee, fruits and vegetables.

However, like America, in our country also, under the guise of providing supplementary income to the farmers, the farmers are induced to rear pigs, sheep, poultry birds etc. on their farm land and then these animals and birds are slaughtered in the co-operative slaughter houses set up in each and every village. The meat and eggs so produced are sold to supplement the income of the farmers. Because these eggs and meat are produced from animals reared within the boundaries of a farm, the meat and eggs obtained from them are described as 'farm products'.

These meat and eggs produced within the boundaries of a farm are mixed with other foodgrains and items like bread, biscuits, coffee or so-called health drinks like Protinule or Bournvita and such other tonics, powders etc. They are labelled with words like 'vitaminised, protein rich tonic food' or 'protein rich farm food'. Such labels help in cheating the people, and thinking that they are made out of farm products i.e. foodgrains or cereals, the people will consume these products with great enthusiasm. The doctors will also recommend to their patients that in the convalescence stage, they should consume such products to overcome the weakness of the diseases.

## **Balanced diet**

In the name of 'balanced diet' the entire population has been very tactfully misled. The ultimate aim of spreading the new concept of 'balanced diet' is to convert the entire population towards meat eating.

The original words prevalent in India were 'nutritious diet' and not 'balanced diet'. Nutritious diet increases the strength of the body and increases 'virya'. The main components of this nutritious diet were pure and fresh milk, pure ghee, various milk products or various sweets made in pure ghee with the flour of gram, udad, mung or wheat.

The Hindu religious scriptures consider 'virya' as the most important thing for physical strength, intelligence and good health. All the food items described above help in increasing 'virya' in the body. A food item which helps in increasing 'virya' necessarily increases strength of the body.

In the concept of balanced diet the importance of 'virya' is totally ignored. The new concept of balanced diet talks of calories, protein, vitamin and other minerals and also lists the sources from which these substances can be procured. The mention of meat, fish and eggs has quietly sneaked into this list. There is an aggressive propaganda to impress that the protein content of meat, fish and eggs is very high and thus the younger generation is slowly diverted towards eating of meat and eggs.

Thus this is a grand conspiracy to brush aside the place of nutritious food and virya and to induce the entire population to eat meat, fish and eggs in the

name of protein. Once people start eating meat and fish, they will stop protesting and agitating against violence. Once this protest stops, they may in fact be induced to practice violence by tempting them with earnings from violence so that the economy of the nation which runs with complementary efforts of the animal power and human power can now be diverted to animal slaughter and export earnings of meat. The people will then be fed on fish flour, so that the foodgrain can be fed to the animals and thus people themselves will become helpful in export of meat.

Thus the concept of 'balanced diet' in place of the concept of 'nutritious diet' is as dangerous as an atom bomb for the entire Hindu population, Hindu religion and Hindu culture.

## **Technology**

'Technology' is an English word. Its meaning in English is 'know-how' and in that sense it is a well known and well practised word in India. However, by using the word 'technology' in its English connotation, an impression is created as though it is something new, and in this way the Western way of life has been thrust upon the urban social life of this country. Now people use this word like a parrot without understanding its real meaning. Now the conspiracy has turned itself towards rural area. 'The rural agricultural technology' aims to wean away the farmers from the traditional plough and divert them towards tractor. Thus they are made dependent on the oil producing countries. Instead of leather buckets pulled by bullocks for drawing water from wells, the farmers are now led towards use of motor pumps and thereby agriculture is made costly. According to the modern technology, they are made to use water from tube well or from canals and thus the canals of corruption have started flowing. The rural technology increases inflation. The users of this technology are mercilessly exploited, the farmers became pawns for exploitation and billions of rupees are earned by the oil producing countries, the vested interests in the fertiliser sector and the owners of giant industries.

As long as the Indian technology was existent in villages, agriculture was cheap, the farmer was independent and he used to feed the entire living world. With the weapon of 'Technology' he was described as an orthodox and backward and his ancient technology was destroyed. In its place the Western technology took over. With this the flood of exploitation, poverty, corruption and slavery has pervaded the entire scene. Such is the effect of the word technology! The independent farmer, after succumbing to the modern technology, has become dependent and a pawn for exploitation.

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
